Next Level Prophetic Discernment: The Breaker Anointing

“The voice of the Lord is powerful.” (Psalm 29:4)

(*koakh* – a force; *dunamis*, force)

I. The Voice of the Lord Brings Breakthrough!

“The voice of the Lord will shatter the enemy!” (Isaiah 30:31)

A. The Breaker is here!

“The breaker [the Messiah, Who opens the way] shall go up before them [liberating them]. They will break out, pass through the gate and go out; so their King goes on before them, the Lord at their head.” (Micah 2:13, AMP)

“He who breaks through has gone up before them; they will break through and pass the gate and go out by it. Then their king will pass on before them, the Lord at their head.” (Micah 2:13, Modern English Version)

“Then I, God, will burst all confinements and lead them out into the open. They’ll follow their King. I will be out in front leading them.” (Micah 2:13, MSG)

1. The word “breaker” in Hebrew is *parats*, which means to break out, to burst forth, compel, to urge, grow, increase, open, to break in pieces, to break up, to break open, to break out (violently), to break off all

limitation!

“Lord, the time has come for You to break through.” (Psalm 119:126, TPT)

“O God, please come and save us again; bring us Your breakthrough-victory!” (Psalm 118:25, TPT)

- a. *Tsalach*—often translated “prosperity”—means to push forward, break out, advance, prosper, become a success.
- b. The prophetic is not just about information but about impartation and a force for transformation.

2. **This is a normal part of our Christian walk.**

- a. Jesus said He would baptize us with the Holy Ghost and fire. (Matthew 3:11)
- b. Jeremiah’s call: To root out, tear down, pull down and destroy; build and plant. (Jeremiah 1:10)
- c. *“My sheep hear My voice.”* (John 10:27)
- d. Holy Spirit mantle of revelation and transformation. (Acts 2)

“But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: ‘And it shall come to pass in the last days,’ says God, ‘That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh. Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your young men shall see visions, your old men shall dream dreams. And on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days; and they shall prophesy.” (Acts 2:14–18)

- e. Jesus never intended us to take on the Great Commission or to turn the world upside down without power or revelation.
 - i. Iran: 70% of new people saved see Jesus in a dream.
 - ii. Sons of Issachar anointing:

Valiant men (1 Chron. 7)

Had understanding of times and knew what to do (1 Chron. 12:32)

- iii. Moses said, *“I would that all the Lord’s people were prophets and that the Lord would put His Spirit upon them all.”* (Numbers 11:29)

B. Prophetic discernment brings breakthrough for open vision strategies of breakthrough for the future.

(In the times of Eli the priest) *“The word of the Lord was precious and there was no open vision.”* (1 Samuel 3:1, KJV)

“The Word of the Lord was rare. There was no widespread revelation.” (NKJV)

“This is why I wait upon You, expecting Your breakthrough, for Your Word brings me hope.” (Psalm 130:5, TPT)

- 1. Where there is no vision, people perish. (Proverbs 29:18)
- 2. People of vision ... see the invisible, hear the inaudible, believe the incredible, think the unthinkable and do the impossible!

C. Open visions of prophetic discernment will reveal:

1. God’s plans and strategies.

“For I know the plans I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you a hope and a future.’”
(Jeremiah 29:11, NIV)

Seeing into God’s prophetic plans will release anointing for breakthrough.

2. The enemy’s strategy.

- a. *“The voice of the Lord shatters the enemy!”* (Isaiah 30:31)
- b. Prophetically seeing into the plans of the enemy also releases the Breaker anointing!

- c. **Example:** Elisha saw into the plans of the Syrian king and exposed the ambush. (2 Kings 6)

D. Prophetic discernment brings breakthrough for open hearts. Connecting with the heart of God makes God real!

“Our hero, come and rescue us! O God of the breakthrough, for the glory of Your name, come and help us! Forgive and restore us, heal us and cover us in Your love.” (Psalm 79:9, TPT)

Example: Jesus’ words opened the heart of the Samaritan woman. (John 4)

1. Open our own hearts.
2. Open the hearts of others.

E. Prophetic discernment brings breakthrough for open heaven and an open earth—gives you the power to change your world!

“A warrior filled with wisdom ascends into the high place and releases breakthrough, bringing down the strongholds of the mighty.” (Proverbs 21:22, TPT)

1. Story of the transformation of our land:

“Rain down, you heavens, from above and let the skies pour down righteousness, let the earth open!” (Isaiah 45:8)

“Let it fall in showers, you heavens, from above and let the skies rain down righteousness ... the pure, spiritual heaven-born possibilities that have their foundation in the holy bang of God. Let the earth open ...” (Isaiah 45:8, AMP)

“Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them. And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who

were paralyzed and lame were healed. And there was great joy in that city.”
(Acts 8:5–8)

2. Church restoration for city transformation.
